The Following are a list of potential fire hazards that we discussed at our safety meeting.

- Candles are not allowed at
- Campus Towers.
- Portable heaters that are warm to the touch are not allowed.
- Keep a 12 inch clearance to the sprinkler pipe in the closet of your apartment.
- If you are not using your stove contact the office to disconnect the power to it.
- Do not use your stove top for storing anything unless you have had it disconnected.
- No smoking is allowed in or around the building except in the designated smoking area.
- Do not disconnect your smoke detector, if it is beeping contact the office and we will come up and fix them for you.

One question was asked during our meeting that I didn't have an answer to was "Where can I dispose of an expired fire extinguisher?"
